- This ranks as the **seventh-largest Powerball jackpot**, and the second-largest Powerball jackpot this year, behind the \$1.787 billion jackpot won on Sept. 6.

- **The jackpot streak has hit the 3-month mark.** Wednesday's drawing will be the 41st drawing in the jackpot run. The game's longest jackpot streak was 42 consecutive drawings, which was recorded at the end of Powerball's last jackpot run on Sept. 6.
 - **Match 4 + PB prize winners!** This jackpot streak, the *Match 4 + Powerball* winners have collectively won more than \$42 million in prize money!!!

- The current jackpot run has also produced 51 *Match 5* winners (\$1 million) and eight *Match 5 + Power Play*® (\$2 million).

- **How is the Powerball Grand Prize estimate determined?**

The two main factors that determine the advertised jackpot annuity are projected ticket sales and the annuity factor. The annuity factor, or cost to fund an annuity prize, is made up of interest rates for securities purchased to fund prize payments. Higher interest rates allow for the purchase of a larger annuitized prize.

- **How do ticket sales surge during major jackpot runs?**

Player participation directly correlates with the advertised jackpot. As the advertised jackpot increases, ticket sales rise as well, which drives the jackpot higher.

- **Do I have less of a chance to win, if more people are playing?**

No, Powerball players have the same chance to win in every Powerball drawing, regardless of how many tickets are sold or how big the jackpot grows.

- The overall odds of winning a prize are 1 in 24.9.
- The odds of winning the jackpot are 1 in 292.2 million.

- **\$2 Ticket Price**

- Powerball has had a \$2 ticket price since 2012.
- The current game matrix and odds have been in place since 2015.

- **Good Causes** – On average, 35% of a \$2 Powerball ticket goes to fund good causes; transfer percentages vary by jurisdiction.

- **Annuity vs. Cash** – Powerball jackpot winners may choose to receive their prize as an annuity or a lump sum payment (cash option). Both advertised prize options are prior to federal and jurisdictional taxes. A jackpot winner who selects the annuity will receive one immediate payment followed by 29 annual payments that increase by 5% each year.

- **Five Powerball jackpots have been won, so far, this year:**

- Jan 18, 2025 - \$328.5 million – Oregon
- Mar 29, 2025 - \$526.5 million – California
- Apr 26, 2025 - \$167.3 million – Kentucky
- May 31, 2025 - \$204.5 million – California
- Sept. 6, 2025 - \$1.787 billion – Missouri, Texas
