



Powerball Fact Sheet – Saturday, Aug. 30 Drawing

Current Estimated Jackpot: \$950 million

\$428.9 million cash value

- National ticket sales continue to trend upward, with a 105.9% increase in ticket sales for the Aug. 27 drawing compared to the previous Wednesday drawing.
- Today's ticket sales, along with tomorrow's updated annuity factor, will determine whether a jackpot increase can be supported.
- SIX tickets won prizes worth \$1 million or more in last night's Powerball drawing!
 - \$1 million tickets – Arizona, New York, Virginia
 - \$2 million tickets – Mississippi, Ohio, Virginia
- There was also an extraordinary amount of *Match 4+PB* winners nationwide –and a 4X multiplier!
 - 40 winning tickets of \$50,000
 - 10 winning tickets of \$200,000 with Power Play 4X multiplier
- \$500,000 Double Play winner in South Dakota!
 - This is the fourth Double Play ticket to win a \$500,000 prize in the last four drawings.
 - The Maryland Lottery sold three \$500,000-winning Double Play tickets last week.
- This remains the 6th largest Powerball jackpot and the game's biggest advertised jackpot in more than a year!

- Saturday's drawing will be the 39th drawing, since the Powerball jackpot was last won in California on May 31, 2025. The game's longest jackpot streak stands at 42 consecutive drawings, which was set on April 6, 2024, with a \$1.326 billion jackpot winner in Oregon.

- Four Powerball jackpots have been won, so far, this year:
 - Jan 18, 2025 - \$328.5 million – Oregon
 - Mar 29, 2025 - \$526.5 million – California
 - Apr 26, 2025 - \$167.3 million – Kentucky
 - May 31, 2025 - \$204.5 million – California
- *How is the Powerball jackpot estimate determined?* The two main factors that determine the advertised jackpot annuity are projected ticket sales and the annuity factor. The annuity factor, or cost to fund an annuity prize, is made up of interest rates for securities purchased to fund prize payments. Higher interest rates allow for the purchase of a larger annuitized prize.
- *Do I have less of a chance to win, if more people are playing?* No, Powerball players have the same chance to win in every Powerball drawing, regardless of how many tickets are sold or how big the jackpot grows.
 - The overall odds of winning a prize are 1 in 24.9.
 - The odds of winning the jackpot are 1 in 292.2 million.
 - The current Powerball game matrix and odds have not changed since 2015.

Jackpot Estimates

- Powerball jackpot winners may choose to receive their prize as an annuity or a lump sum payment (cash option). Both advertised prize options are prior to federal and jurisdictional taxes.
- Both advertised prize options are *estimates* based on projected ticket sales and interest rates. Differences between the estimates and final amounts may occur based on final tickets sales.



- A jackpot winner who selects the annuity will receive one immediate payment followed by 29 annual payments that increase by 5% each year.
- How much of a Powerball ticket goes to the jackpot? 50% of a \$2 Powerball ticket goes to fund prizes. From that dollar, 68 cents go to the jackpot prize pool, the remaining 32 cents go to the lower-tier prize pool. Powerball has set cash prizes for lower-tier prize categories, because the number of lower-tier prizes awarded increases as sales increase.

About Powerball®

Powerball® holds the current world record for largest national lottery jackpot at \$2.04 billion. Since its first drawing in 1992, the game has helped generate more than \$36 billion for good causes supported by U.S. lotteries. More than half of all proceeds from the sale of a Powerball ticket remain in the jurisdiction where the ticket was sold. Powerball tickets are \$2 per play. Tickets are sold in 45 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands. Powerball drawings are broadcast live every Monday, Wednesday and Saturday at 10:59 p.m. ET from the Florida Lottery draw studio in Tallahassee.
